ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Yola 2019 is the 50th edition of the Annual Conferences of the Entomological Society of Nigeria, which brings together experts from around the globe to discuss scientific findings and trends in the previous years. This edition is to be hosted by Yola/Jalingo/Gombe Branch of the Society at the AMERICAN UNIVERSITY OF NIGERIA (AUN) YOLA, Adamawa State, Nigeria.

THEME: BIODIVERSITY AND CONSERVATION IN ENTOMOLOGY: PROSPECTS AND CHALLENGES IN THE 21ST CENTURY

SUMMARY:

Biodiversity is the variety of life on Earth at all levels ranging from genes to species and ecosystems. It is the foundation for all of the life sciences. There is a broad scientific consensus that biological diversity is currently being eroded globally at a rate unprecedented in human history. We know that increasing loss of biodiversity is altering biosphere-level processes that we depend on.

There is urgency in conducting biodiversity studies because the burgeoning human populations and associated human activities worldwide are rapidly eliminating natural habitats that sustain biodiversity. The causes of biodiversity loss include human impacts on habitats (habitat destruction, fragmentation, restructuring), organisms (over-exploitation, introduction of invasive species, predators, parasites), and natural disasters (earthquakes, hurricanes, tsunamis, etc).

Biodiversity is essential to human well-being; the quality of air, water, and food depends on the renewable cycles and healthy ecosystems that are driven by biodiversity.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE:

- Participants will be trained on the identification, handling and preservation of insect species.
- The conference will provide an opportunity for participants (entomologists) to relate and share experiences in their various research specialties.
- The conference will afford stakeholders in the academia and industries, the opportunity to discuss insects in relation to agriculture, animal health, public health, environment and biorisks management strategies in the field and laboratory.
- The conference will provide the platform for entomologists to explore ways by which beneficial or natural enemies would be conserved, while the medical entomologists will proffer alternatives to the trending challenges posed by vectors.
- There will be opportunity in the conference for professionals and students who have distinguished themselves in various research areas to discuss the role of insects in biodiversity and conservation, in the face of the emerging global challenges.
